Nicky Perfect

Keynote Speaker



Nicky Perfect is an international hostage and crisis negotiator turned world renowned trainer and speaker.

She spent 31 years as a Metropolitan police officer and the last 10 of those years as an international hostage and crisis negotiator.

Nicky worked on the elite New Scotland Yard Hostage and Crisis Negotiation Unit. She has travelled the world teaching negotiation and working with Her Majesty's Government on international operations and has had the privilege of talking to hundreds of people in crisis.

Nicky spent many years as the Director of UK Training of the National Hostage and Crisis Negotiation Course. She was the first female to be posted to this role and became responsible for designing and training police officers across the UK, to deal with life and death situations from suicide intervention to crime in action (kidnaps).

In the 2022 Queen's New Year's Honours List, she was awarded the British Empire Medal for "meritorious service to the community during the pandemic".

She is the author of "Crisis – true stories from my life as a hostage negotiator" published by HQ Harper Collins and a best seller on Amazon. She has appeared on both radio, TV, in podcasts and in the press as an expert in negotiation and communication – including BBC Radio 4s Woman's Hour, Crimewatch, Good Housekeeping, Woman's Own, Daily Mail, BBC Radio 3 Counties,

Devorah, a London native, has studied and worked in London, Paris and Israel. With a Bachelor of Arts from Sorbonne University and a Master of Arts from Edinburgh University, she has worked at Les Archives Nationales in Paris and for the office of the Chief Rabbi of Savyon, Israel.

With over two decades of educational experience, Devorah has taught a range of subjects, including parenting skills, Jewish philosophy and theology, self-esteem for children and teenagers, and personal development for both children and adults. Throughout, her dedication to education and communication has remained unwavering.

Transitioning to conflict resolution, her tenure at the London Beth Din, a Jewish court of law, inspired her to pursue accreditation as a mediator with the FMA under the Family Mediation Council. Today, she serves as an accredited mediator and child inclusive (CIM) mediator. Alongside her co-mediator, Venetia Tosswill, she operates under three reputable mediation firms: Sage Mediation, True North Mediation, and Turner & Johnson Mediation. Her understanding of both civil and Jewish divorce procedures enriches her mediation practice, illustrating her commitment to helping clients achieve amicable resolutions as they transition to the next phase of their lives.

Devorah serves clients from diverse backgrounds, including both Jewish and non-Jewish individuals. She regularly guides clients with varying levels of religious commitment through the civil and Jewish divorce processes.

Zaza is dually qualified as a medical doctor and solicitor, as well as being a highly experienced mediator and International Commercial Arbitrator (CIArb). She is an active pluralist and fluent in Arabic and she frequently contributes to the prevention of and response to radicalization through mediation and mentoring often working alongside the Metropolitan Police. As a Conflict Resolution Trainer, Restorative Justice Practitioner and Community Leader for Muslim Women, Zaza also delivers a range of courses and seminars in Churches, Mosques, Schools and Universities as well teaching children (including those with Special Educational Needs) to handle conflicts with their peers, siblings and parents more constructively. Her commitment to improving the levels of engagement within ethnic and religious communities is strongly evidenced by her founding of the charity BIMA, a multi-faith association of Mediators and Arbitrators.

Zaza's work can involve dealing with those whose behaviour or beliefs might be very challenging so her approach encompasses using positive reinforcement tactics to promote good behaviour.
