Profile

Charlotte specialises in complex children disputes. Her expertise includes international cases in the High

Court (including child abduction, FGM, forced marriage and surrogacy), and those cases which involve the most serious allegations of domestic and sexual abuse, and controlling and coercive behaviour. She has extensive experience of advising and appearing in internal and international relocation cases, especially those with tricky factual backgrounds.

She is recognised as a leading junior in both Chambers & Partners and the Legal 500 where she is commended for her strategic approach, meticulous preparation and formidable advocacy.

Since becoming a tenant at 4PB in 2017, Charlotte has been instructed in some of the key appellate cases instrumental in shaping children law, both in the Court of Appeal and the Supreme Court. She has acted for a number of charities and NGOs as interveners in such matters and is always happy to discuss similar opportunities as they arise. In addition to her work in the Family Court, she was instructed in the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse and has a keen interest in matters which feature an overlap between the Family Court and other areas of law.

Private children law

Charlotte is frequently instructed in cases where there are serious allegations of domestic abuse, sexual abuse and controlling and coercive behaviour. She appeared in the leading Court of Appeal case on coercive control: *Re H-N and Others (Children) (Domestic Abuse: Finding of fact hearings) [2021] EWCA Civ 448*. She is always pleased to be instructed at an early stage of the litigation and to advise on strategy, in particular with regards to evidential issues.

In addition to her domestic abuse practice, she is well versed in representing applicants and respondents in internal and international relocation cases, including to non-1980 Hague Convention countries where she is able to draw from her international child abduction practice. Charlotte has delivered seminars on preparing such applications (and defending them) to solicitors' firms.

Charlotte understands that private law children disputes are acutely stressful for those involved in them and is well recognised in the legal directories for her client care skills. She is as comfortable representing high net worth clients as she is those in receipt of legal aid.
